Scholarship FAQs

Where does the scholarship money come from?

Scholarships are made possible through the direct donations of generous individuals and organizations. Scholarship money is not raised from the fees we charge our registrants. Who is eligible to receive a scholarship?

All prospective students with financial needs are eligible to apply.

Am I guaranteed a scholarship?

It is our desire that no student miss out on the Irish Way experience because of financial circumstances. Unfortunately, we rely on the donations of others for the scholarship fund; therefore, we cannot guarantee every request will be granted.

How do I register?

You must register and provide the deposit to hold your spot, however, if for any reason you are denied a scholarship and unable to attend, this deposit will be refunded to you in full. When sending your registration form and deposit, be sure to include the financial aid application as well.

What kind of deposit will be required?

A deposit of \$500 will be required at the time of registration.

How will I find out if I received a scholarship?

Irish Way will notify recipients by phone or email.

Does the scholarship cover all costs for the student?

No. Scholarships are given based on individual needs. The parent or guardian is responsible to pay any portion not covered by scholarship. If your student receives a scholarship, please keep in mind that incidentals are not covered by scholarship funds and you will need to provide your child with spending money.
